

Cleaning Guide

What you need to ensure is cleaned prior to you vacating.

General Cleaning Duties

- Clean all windows & window tracks, built in wardrobes & tracks
- Clean fly screens and security screens
- Vacuum/mop floors, remove marks on floors and skirting boards
- Wash walls with attention to, door handles, light switches
- Dust light fittings, wipe down cob webs and dusty globes
- Air-conditioners filters to be cleaned
- Top of cupboards

Kitchen

- Inside and outside of the cupboards
- Stove, inside griller, drip trays and oven to be cleaned of grease
- Exhaust fans and filters
- Sink (stainless steel cleaners)
- Rangehood and filter to be cleaned of grease

Bathroom

- Floor and wall tiles, mirror and windows
- Toilet, vanity, bath and shower
- Clean inside and outside cupboard
- Shower curtain, washed and bleached
- Grouting in shower and bathtub
- All products removed from bathroom

Laundry

- Inside, outside and behind washing machine, rinse filter
- Inside, outside and behind dryer, remove lint
- Clean laundry tub including bottom of the cupboard

Verandah/Patio/Garden

- Sweep and mop tiles, clean railings and any glass, remove cobwebs
- Clean driveway, carports (all concrete to be removed of car oil)
- Lawns, edges weeding and general tidy-up (no rubbish to be left behind)
- Gutter cleaner

Pets

If you signed your lease with a Pet Clause, you will need to arrange for professional pest exterminator to spray both internally and externally of the premises for fleas. Ensure you retain a copy of this paid for refund of bond.

General Information

Please ensure that you retain all copies of statements and invoices of proof of maintenance as you will be required to show proof that maintenance work has been carried out.

Once all matters have been settled and final payments have been made including payments for water or other charges your bond monies will be released.
